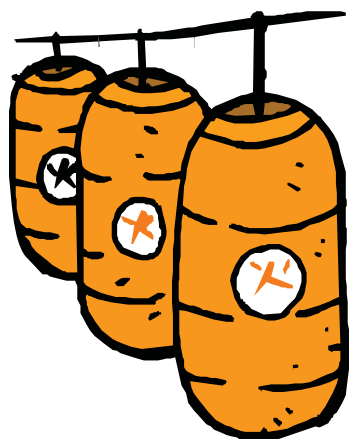

TO BECOME CHAMPIONS...

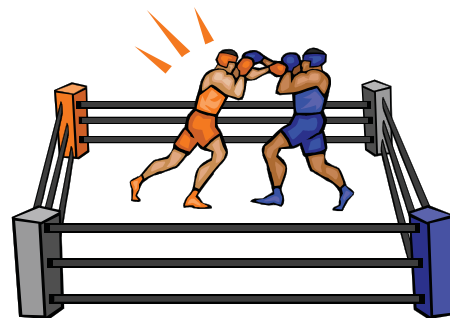
...you and I must learn to live by the Fruit of the Spirit, and fight against our sin on a daily basis.

This is no easy workout, and will require time, sweat, training, and effort.

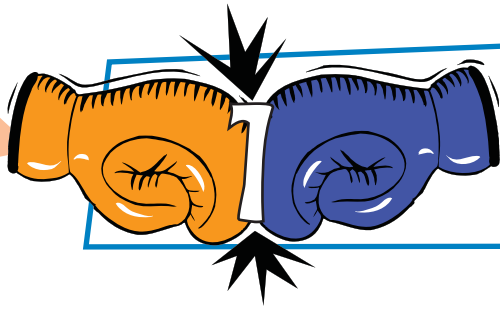


Come to this class each week for your workout and training and listen to your coach. Learn the memory verse, hear the Bible story, and get help with how to knockout the sin that wars within your heart.

Then during the week, get into the ring as you put into practice each lesson in your real life. Each time you do the homework assignment titled "In the Ring," you are throwing a great punch at sin!



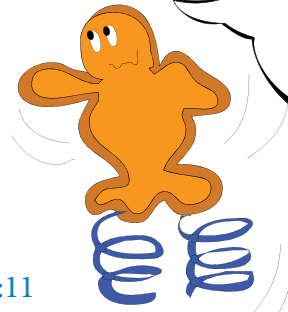
