FAITH CELLPHONE

The 7 drawings for the faith cellphone represent the 7 lessons on faithfulness. We recommend that you mention each lesson title as you slide the "images film" through the craft cellphone.

Materials:

- Cell Template with images film (1 per student)
- Simple Ribbon / cut 30 cm (1 per student)
- Bead (1 per student)
- Optional: colors, crayons or scissors.

Instructions:

- 1. Cut out the cellphone and images film.
- 2. Assemble the cellphone template.
- 3. Thread the ribbon through the hole and tie on the bead.
- 4. Check to make sure the images film fits into the slits cut into the cellphone. If it does not, cut it down until it fits correctly.
- 5. Play with the students to see what message is being sent or received on their cellphones.




GENTLENESS ROAD

Materials:

- Roads and Signs Template (1 per student)
- Optional: crayons, pens, a small toy car, glue or tape.

Instructions:

- 1. Cut out the road signs and road sign bases.
- 2. Fold the bases on the dotted lines.
- 3. Glue the signs to the bases.
- 4. Distribute them along the "gentleness" road.
- 5. Use the following questions for students to know if they are making progress on "The Gentleness Road.





- Your sister breaks your favorite toy. Do you get angry or are you gentle with her?
- Your parents ask you to take care of your little brother and you were going out to play with your friends. What do you do? Do you stay to play with your little brother, caring for someone smaller?
- In the church there is someone who sings a lot better than you. Do you give them a bad look or do you acknowledge that they are better than you?

SELF-CONTROL TRAFFIC LIGHT

Materials:

- Traffic light template
- 3 Foamy circles (red, yellow, and green)
- Optional: Red, yellow and green glitter, and glue, tape or liquid silicone.

Instructions:

- 1. Cut out the traffic light from the template.
- 2. Glue on the red, yellow and green foamy circles in the corresponding areas.
- 3. Optional: You can glue glitter to the circles to make them brighter.

You can also use the song "Knock out my Sin" on the champions CD, to play with the students while you point to traffic light colors.
