Put a little perfume on a sheet of paper, let it dry, and draw a picture of yourself. Treasure it and pray to God that your life will always be fragrant 5

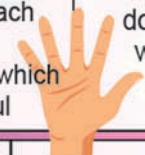
Tell God about something you need in your life and read Psalm 16:1 6

Pray thanking God for your family, and have a family game time 12

Write some encouragement to a friend you haven't seen and study John 15:13 with your parents 13

With the help of your parents, make an acrostic using your name. For each letter, write one of your qualities 14

Learn Proverbs 4:23, then draw a heart and fill it with pieces of paper 15

Go out with your parents and household to pick up the garbage from your street 16

Read Acts 16:31 and pray asking God for protection for your parents and siblings 17

Write on your hand the name of someone who has offended you, while you wash your hand, pray to God and forgive them 19

Read Matthew 19:19 and discuss the meaning of the text with your parents 20

Pray for the children who have no family, for the healing of their hearts, for good families, and that they find love and healing through a relationship with Jesus 23

Read Genesis 28:15. Think about what God wants to do with you from now on 24



Record a video reading a Bible verse and send it to your friends 25

Pray thanking God for everything he has given you, organize your room and give away what you no longer use 26

Thank God for what he has given you, ask him to protect you, your family and your friends 27

Memorize Matthew 7:12. You can ask your parents for help 28

Draw a tree and some apples (or some fruit). In each apple write one of your dreams then pray to God to be able to reach them 29

If there is a grandparent on your street, go with your parents to ask if they need anything 30

Open the jar with the papers you wrote in the month. Read them and thank God, because although there is a crisis, He is faithful. 31
