a. Sun in your garden: Preventing problems!

Kit for the teacher. It is much easier to teach if you take a kit with you to the classroom every week. You can just look for the extra things that are needed for an activity. Here are some ideas to put in your kit:

For Activities

b. Water your garden: Showing love to the children!

If they are small you can use three pictures of the class and the children can order them according to the biblical story. Have fun with your students and enjoy teaching the word of God.
