

# CRAFT INSTRUCTIONS

## Heroes of the Faith, Unit 1



### CARD ENVELOPE

Use this envelope to hold the cards that the children collect by attending each week.

#### MATERIALS

- 1 Envelope pattern
- Colors
- Glue

#### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut or punch out the envelope pattern along solid lines, fold on dashed lines.
2. Color the envelope and write your name in the box.
3. Glue the flaps on the sides of the envelope.
4. Insert the top flap into the slit to close the envelope.



### VISOR

#### MATERIALS

- Visor pattern
- Starburst pattern
- Colors
- Glue
- Curly ribbon

#### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Color the visor pattern.
2. Cut or punch out the visor and the Heroes logo and punch holes on the ends of the visor.
3. Cut or punch out the star shapes / starbursts in foamy or color paper. Each child receives two big and two little star shapes.
4. Glue the stars onto the visor and glue the Heroes logo on top of the stars for a 3D effect.
5. Tie the curly ribbon or string into the holes on both sides of the visor and tie it onto the child's head.



# PUPPET STAGE

Enjoy telling Bible stories with this stage and stick puppets.

## MATERIALS

- 1 Stage and character pattern
- 2 Plastic drinking straws
- Curly ribbon
- Colors
- Scissors
- Glue or tape

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Color the front frame of the stage, the scene, and the characters.
2. Cut or punch out the pieces. Cut along solid lines, fold along dashed lines.
3. Glue the flaps on each side together. Make sure the holes are aligned.
4. Glue the scene on the inside as a background for the stage.
5. Glue the characters to the ends of the straws. We suggest the two men go on two straws, then the woman and donkey go on the back of the men.
6. Tie curly ribbon through the holes in a long loop to hang on the neck.
