

CRAFT INSTRUCTIONS – HEROES

Heroes of the Faith, Unit 2

STORY OF SAMSON

The children will enjoy telling the story of Samson in this fun way with different parts of his life.

MATERIALS

- 1 Craft pattern
- Colours (crayons, pens, etc.)
- Glue
- Plastic drinking straw
- Brad (paper fastener)
- Scissors



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut the craft pattern along solid lines and colour the pictures.
2. In the centre of both circles of paper, punch a small hole to insert the brad. The complete circle goes underneath and the circle with one side missing goes on top to see the pictures underneath.
3. Cut three pieces of the plastic straw. Glue one on Samson's eyes and the other two over the word "Samson" on the upper circle.
4. Cut out the extra eyes and name "Samson" and glue them onto the straw pieces to give them a 3-dimensional effect.

Now you can use it to tell the story of Samson!

ROYAL CROWN

MATERIALS

- Crown pattern for each child
- 4 Larger diamond shapes in colour paper
- 4 Smaller diamond shapes in paper of a different colour
- Colours (crayons, pens, etc.)
- Glue
- Ribbon or string
- Sequins



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Colour the crown with your favourite colours.
2. Cut out the crown pattern and punch holes in both ends for the string.
3. Glue the sequins to the circles on the points of the crown.
4. Glue the large diamonds between the vertical lines. Glue the smaller diamonds on top of the larger ones to represent jewels on the crown.
5. Tie ribbon or string on the ends of the crown and use them to tie it onto the child's head.
The crown is ready to wear! You can use the crown for any of the stories of king Saul, David, or Solomon.

JESUS IS THE WAY (DOOR HANGAR)

The children Will enjoy decorating the doors or any part of their house with this fun hangar.

MATERIALS

- 1 Hangar pattern
- 3 White clouds of White paper or foamy
- 2 Brown tree trunks of paper or foamy
- 2 Green tree tops of paper or foamy
- 8 Brown rocks of foamy or paper
- Colours (crayons, pens, etc.)
- Scissors
- Glue

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut out the hangar pattern along the outside line. Don't forget to cut the circle out of the top.
 2. Colour the scene with your favourite colours.
 3. Glue the clouds to the sky area near the picture of Jesus.
 4. Glue the rocks to the pathway.
 5. Finally glue the tree trunks and tree tops to put trees along the pathway.
- It is ready to take the craft home and put it on a doorknob or hang it in the house!
