

HEROES GAME INSTRUCTIONS

This is a game your students can play to help them learn how to relate godly qualities to real situations in their lives. We suggest using the cards as a reward for attendance, telling the children to come every week and collect them so they can play the game with each other.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Give each child their Hero and Specialty cards that they have earned by attending class each week. We suggest you write on the back of the cards the name of the student to whom they belong. To play the game, children get into pairs. Then for each round of the game, do the following:

- The teacher reads one of the provided situations / questions, but do not say what attribute is needed for that situation.
- The players guess what attribute is needed in that situation and search among their Heroes for the one that has the most points in that attribute. The players can also select optional Specialty cards to help them win.
- Once each opponent is ready with a Hero and Specialty card combination that they believe will win, on the count of 3, they place their cards face-up in the centre of the table at the same time. Note: the first few rounds you play, give the children more time to think to learn how to play. After that, push them to decide very quickly to make it more exciting.
- The player who has the most points in the correct characteristic after calculating points from the Hero cards and Specialty cards wins the round. Keep score, counting how many rounds each child wins.
- Each card can only be played once in the game. After each round, each player takes the cards they just played and sets them to the side face-down.
- Play more rounds until the children run out of cards to play.

The winner is the player who won the most rounds. Have the children change to a different opponent and play again.

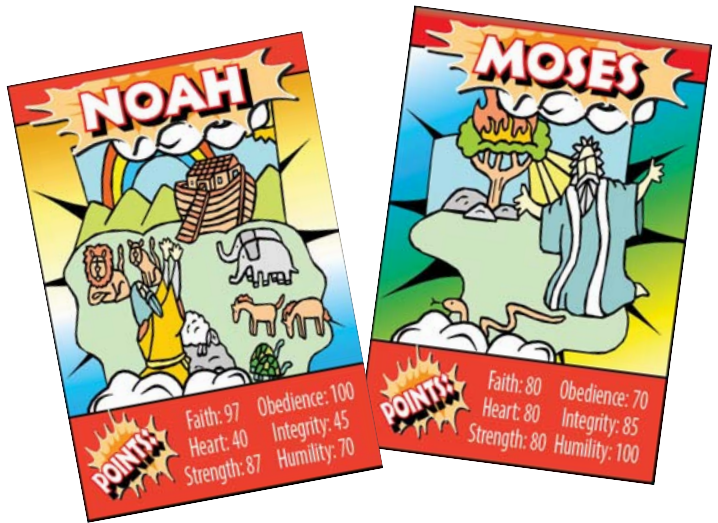

HERO CARDS:

There are two types of cards: Hero cards and Specialty cards. The Hero cards each depict a person from the Bible with assigned values for the following six qualities: **Strength, Integrity, Obedience, Humility, Heart** and **Faith**.

Each hero of the Scripture has up to 100 points for each of these qualities, estimated from an analysis of their lives. If a hero did not have the opportunity to prove himself in a certain area, he will not receive points in that area. Two heroes cannot have the same number of points of the same characteristic. If a hero showed weakness in one area, he will have fewer points than another hero never showed weakness in that area.

Examples: Since we do not see much Faith in Abel's life, he will receive only 50 points for Faith. Since he was killed early in his life, he receives only one point for Strength. He receives 90 points for Heart, because he gave God what God really wanted and showed his love for God. Abraham loses integrity points for lying about his wife, calling her his sister. Noah loses heart points because it is not recorded that he interceded for thousands or millions of people who were about to die in the flood or attempted to save them. Moses has 100 full points in Humility because the Bible says he was the humblest man that ever lived. Joseph has only 20 points in Humility because he told his brothers about the dreams God gave him when it was unnecessary, and we don't see much humility when he became prime minister. Abraham shows 97 in Obedience because he left his land to follow the Lord's leadership and he obeyed by leaving Sodom and Gomorrah. But he does not receive the full 100 points because Noah was even more obedient in building the great ark, working for an estimated 100 years without seeing signs of rain.



SPECIALTY CARDS:

Specialty cards change the value of the cards being played. Using these can help you win even if you and your opponent choose the same Hero.

- **Bible:** increase the score by the indicated points in the quality that you choose. Be sure to use the part of the Bible where the Hero is found.
- **Hidden Gold:** subtract 10 points from your opponent's hero.
- **Prayer:** add 10 points to the **Faith** of your hero.
- **Ark of the Covenant:** reduce your opponent's **Strength** to zero.
- **Fallen Tree:** reduce your opponent's **Humility** by 20 points.
- **Creation:** use this in a round where you think you are going to win. If you win, you can redeem three cards you have previously played.
- **The Sword of the Lord:** use this card to win the round automatically. This card can be used alone.
- **Fire of God:** make your opponent skip a turn.
- **Leprosy:** lose the round but reduce the **Strength** of all your opponent's heroes to 20 points for the rest of the game.
- **Captivity:** Use this card to win your round. Also take a random hero from your opponent, disabling it for the rest of the game.



EXAMPLE ROUNDS

For this example, Child 1 and Child 2 have these cards from attending different weeks.



ROUND 1



Question: "If your sister asks you to tell a lie, which hero will help you?"
Attribute needed: **Integrity** (do not tell the children)
The teacher waits a moment for the children to think, then counts to 3.



Child 1 selects Isaac and the Bible, guessing the quality is Integrity.

Child 2 selects Abraham and Hidden Gold, guessing the quality is Faith.



Note: he must select the Pentateuch Bible card because Isaac's story is in Genesis.



Faith points are not counted because the attribute needed is not Faith but Integrity in this round.

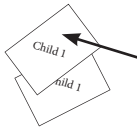


Isaac: 90 Integrity
Bible: +20 points
(-10 points)

Abraham: 77 Integrity
Hidden Gold: -10 points for opponent

Each player sets aside the cards that they just played into a discard pile in preparation for the next round. A card can only be played once per game.



Write the child's name on the back of his cards so he doesn't lose them.

The remaining cards are available for the next round.

ROUND 2



Question: "A friend of yours comes and tells you that you are doing something wrong, and you know that you are wrong, and you need to acknowledge it and apologize. Which hero will help you?"
Attribute needed: **Humility** (do not tell the children)



Child 1 selects Moses and Creation.

Child 2 selects the Sword of the Lord, a card that can be played alone.



Moses: 100 Humility
Creation: If were to win, he would get 3 cards back from his discard pile.



Sword of the Lord wins all rounds.



100 Humility

(He thinks he will win.)

END

When one of the players runs out of cards, the game ends. The child who won the most rounds wins the game! Have the children change opponents and play again.
