





### BOOTCAMP

Draw a picture of yourself with an angel helping you in some way. Think of some dangerous places and scary situations that you face.






Bring a Bible to school and don't hide it in your backpack or bag. Stand up for what you believe and do not be ashamed to be a Christian.






Think of a lie that you told and write it down. It's ok if it was not recent, but when you were smaller. Now list all the lies that followed to keep the first lie from being found out. Write down who got hurt because of that lie?



Who do you know and respect because of the way they live and treat others? (Like Cornelius in today's Bible story.) Write a sentence telling one evidence of their good life, and then go tell them about it.




It is time to find out how it feels to not be ready to tell somebody about the gospel. First, imagine walking or running down the street without your shoes on. Ouch! Next, write what you would say to somebody who asked you how to become a Christian.





This week write down a list of things you believe from the Bible even though they are not visible, but that you believe anyway. Which one from your list will the enemy attack you with specifically? **7** 





Write on the first page of your Bible where and when you prayed for salvation. If you cannot remember, you can do it right now! Go to a special place (in your bedroom, behind your house, or in the church) and ask God to forgive you. Thank Jesus for paying for your sins with his life, and ask him to be your lord and boss. Tell Him you want to live for Him. Write the time and place on the front page of your Bible or on your student book.

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


Memorize a Bible verse that applies to a battle that you are fighting regularly, and tell it to your teacher next week. You could be experiencing fears about your appearance, possessions, wanting more, spiritual security, or your future.





Habits take 21 daily repetitions to become real. Start praying every evening when you climb into bed. It's ok if it's a short simple prayer, but it's not ok to miss a day. If you miss a day, pray twice as long the next morning before you get out of bed. Turn your bed into your prayer place. Reward yourself when you get to 21 days of prayer.





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
