Bible story:

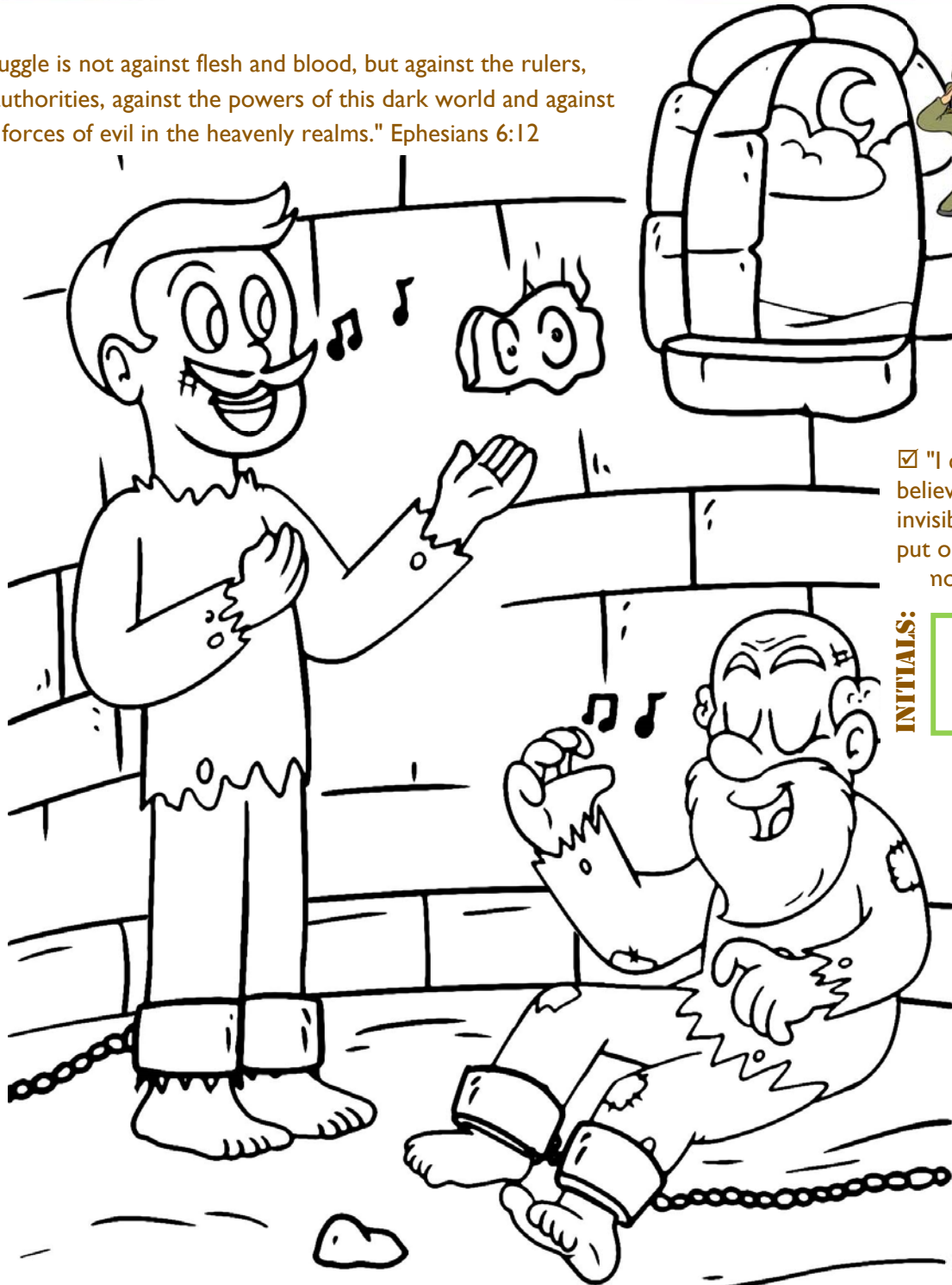
Paul and Silas in jail

"I choose to stand firm."

INITIALS:



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Bring a Bible to school and don't hide it in your backpack or bag. Stand up for what you believe and do not be ashamed to be a Christian.





LESSON 4

Belt of truth

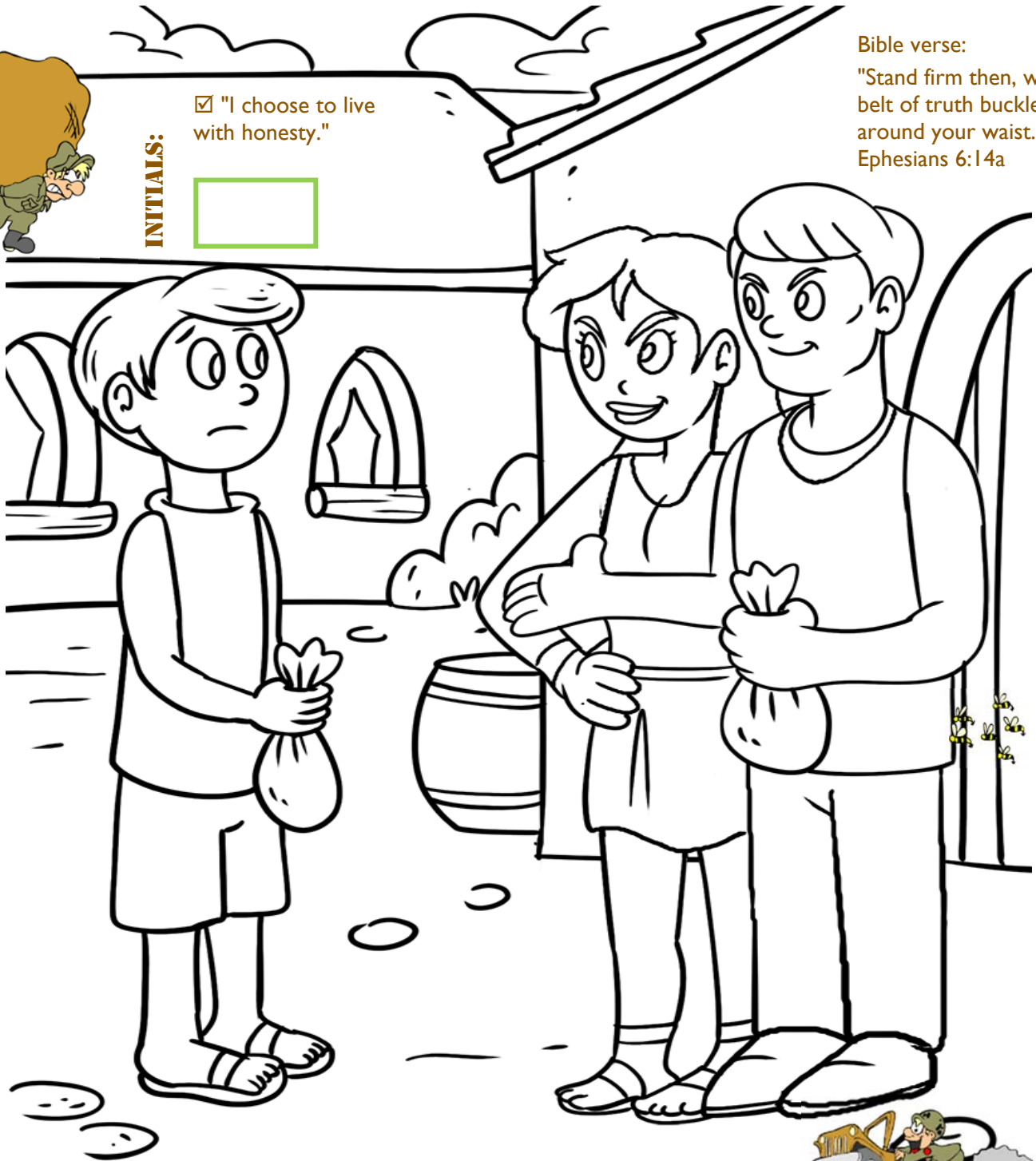
Bible story:

INITIALS:

"I choose to live with honesty."

Bible verse:
"Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist..."
Ephesians 6:14a



BOOTCAMP

LESSON 5

Breastplate of righteousness

Bible story:
Cornelius
(Acts 10:9-23)



Bible verse:
"...with the breastplate of righteousness in place..." Ephesians 6:14b

"I choose to always do the right thing."

INITIALS:



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Who do you know and respect because of the way they live and treat others? (Like Cornelius in today's Bible story.) Write a sentence telling one evidence of their good life, and then go tell them about it.



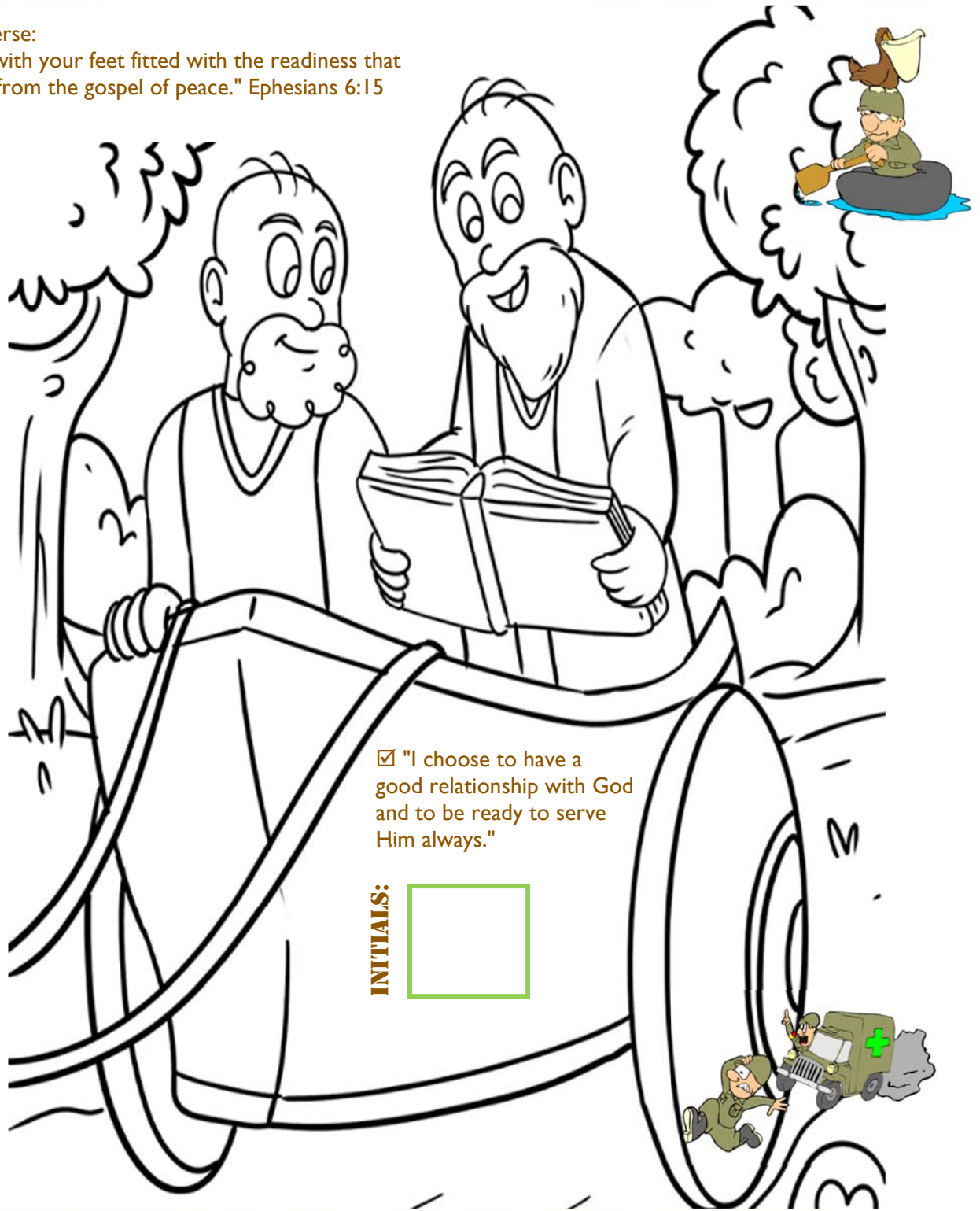
LESSON 6

Bible verse:

INITIALS:



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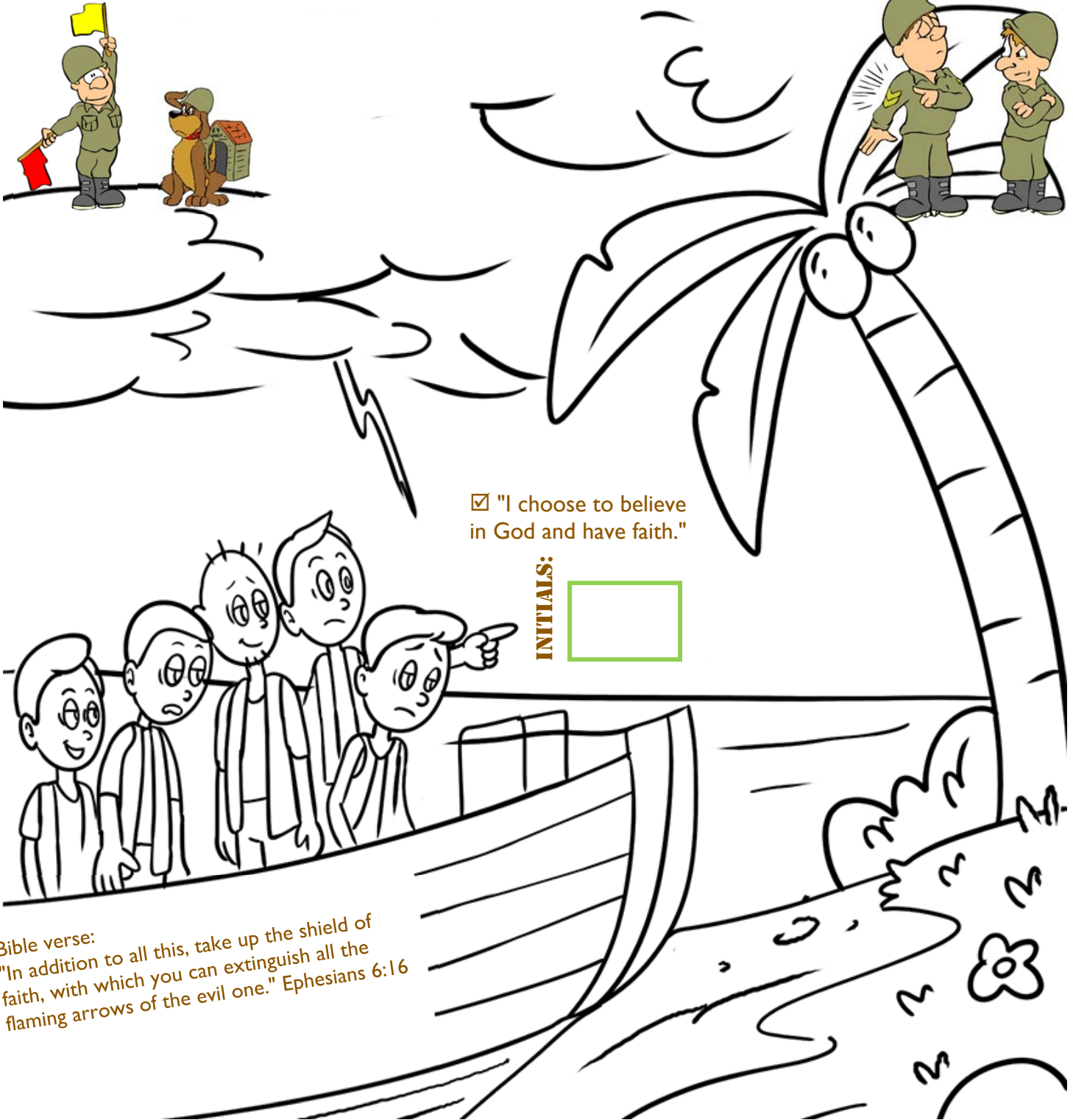

LESSON 7

Shield of faith

Bible story:
Paul and the shipwreck

INITIALS:

Bible verse:
"In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one." Ephesians 6:16

LESSON 8

Helmet of salvation

Bible story:
Saul's conversion
(Acts 9:1-19)



"I choose to trust in the Lord Jesus Christ for my salvation."

Bible verse:
"Take the helmet of salvation..."
Ephesians 6:17a

INITIALS:



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Write on the first page of your Bible where and when you prayed for salvation. If you cannot remember, you can do it right now! Go to a special place (in your bedroom, behind your house, or in the church) and ask God to forgive you. Thank Jesus for paying for your sins with his life, and ask him to be your lord and boss. Tell Him you want to live for Him. Write the time and place on the front page of your Bible or on your student book.



LESSON 9

Sword of the Spirit

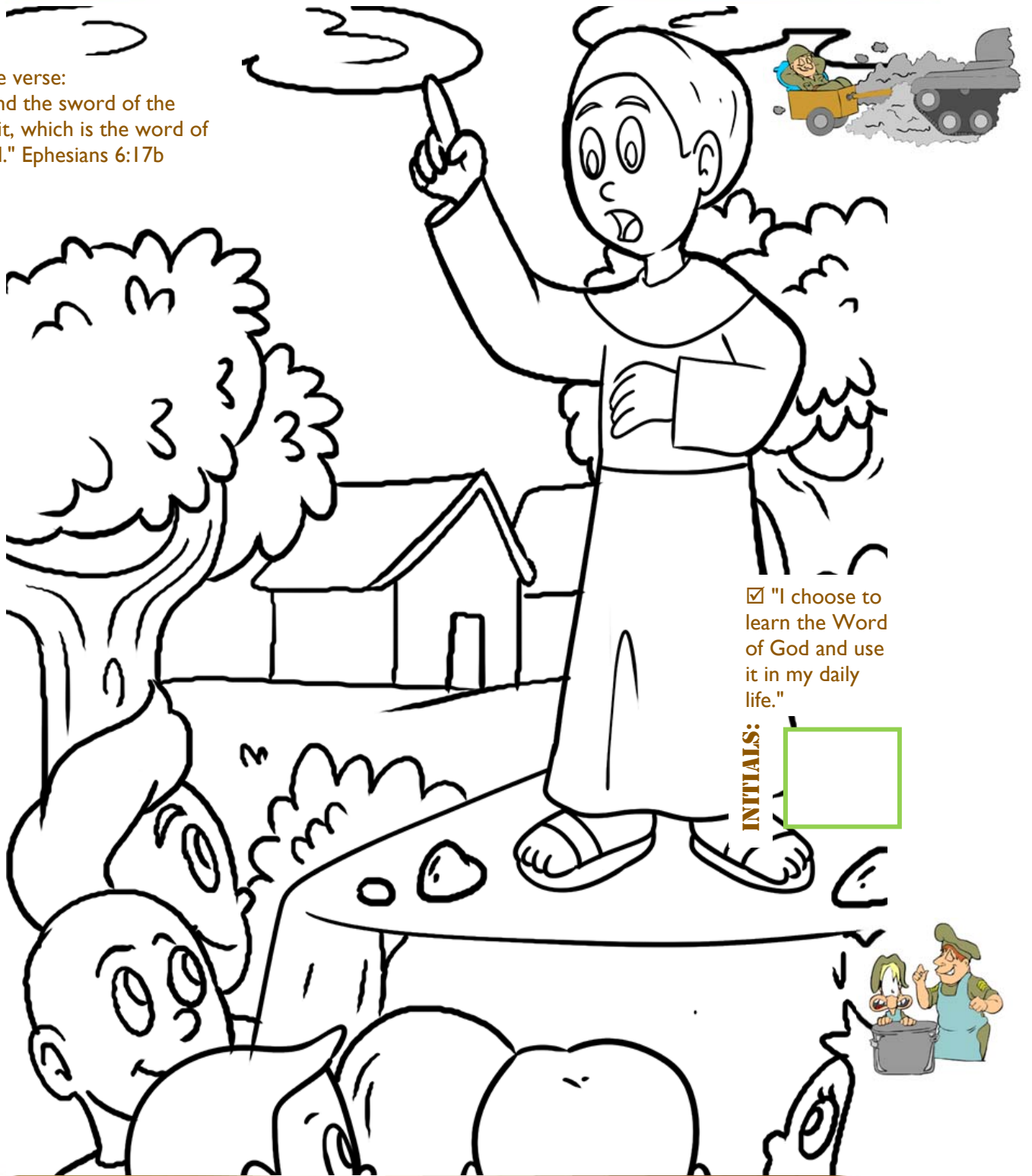
Bible story:

Bible verse:

"...and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God." Ephesians 6:17b



"I choose to learn the Word of God and use it in my daily life."

INITIALS:

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Memorize a Bible verse that applies to a battle that you are fighting regularly, and tell it to your teacher next week. You could be experiencing fears about your appearance, possessions, wanting more, spiritual security, or your future.



LESSON 10

Pray without ceasing

Bible story:
Peter speaks to the multitude
(Acts 12:1-19)



☑ "I choose to pray always, remembering that the battle is spiritual."

INITIALS:



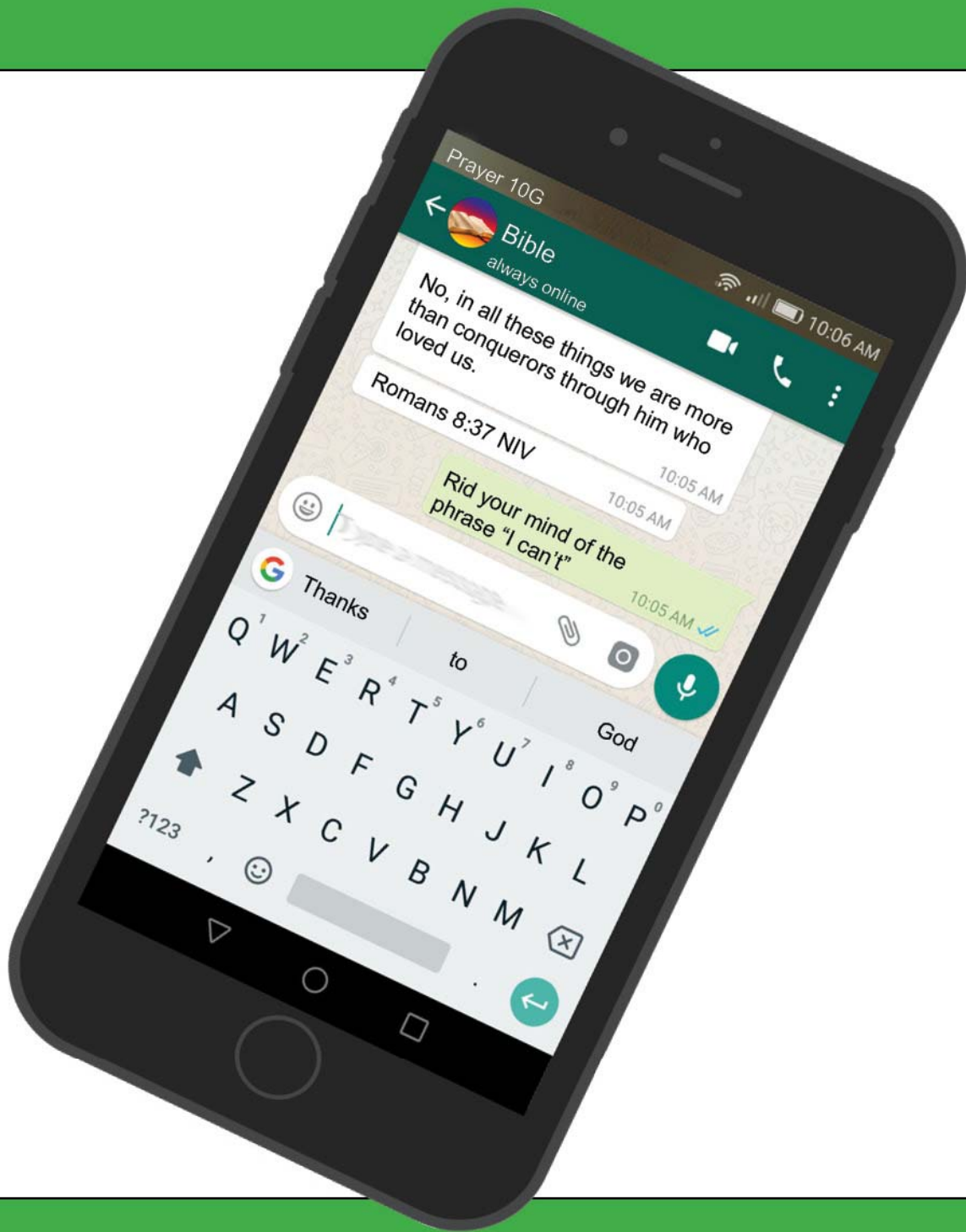
Bible verse:

"And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people." Ephesians 6:18



BOOTCAMP

Habits take 21 daily repetitions to become real. Start praying every evening when you climb into bed. It's ok if it's a short simple prayer, but it's not ok to miss a day. If you miss a day, pray twice as long the next morning before you get out of bed. Turn your bed into your prayer place. Reward yourself when you get to 21 days of prayer.
