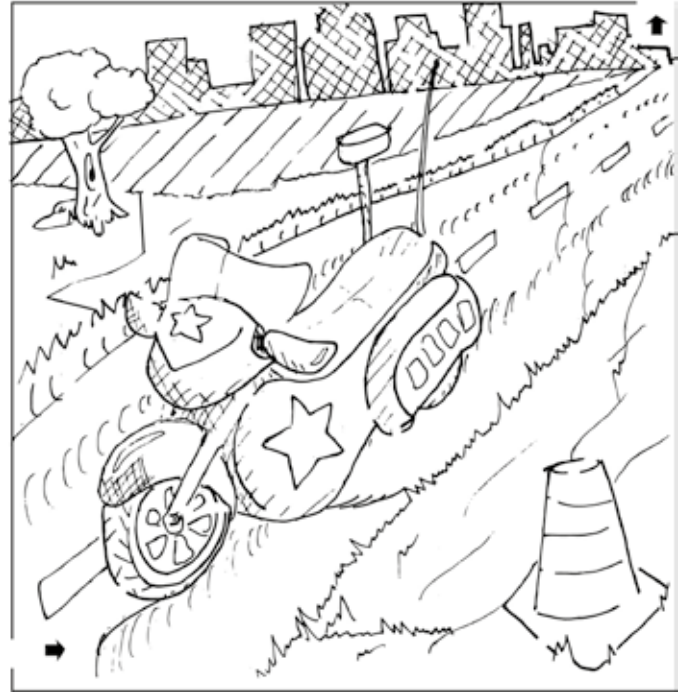

4. What do you have to do to hide something from your teacher, mom, dad, police, etc?

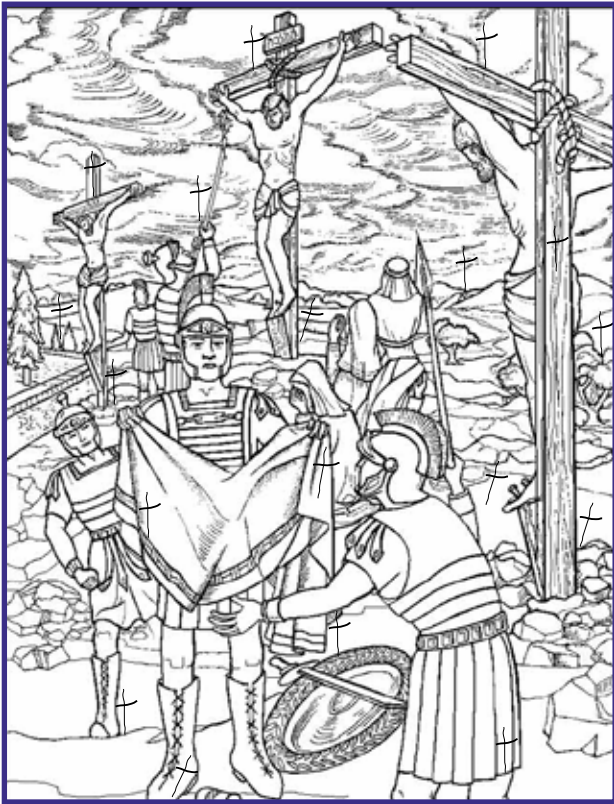

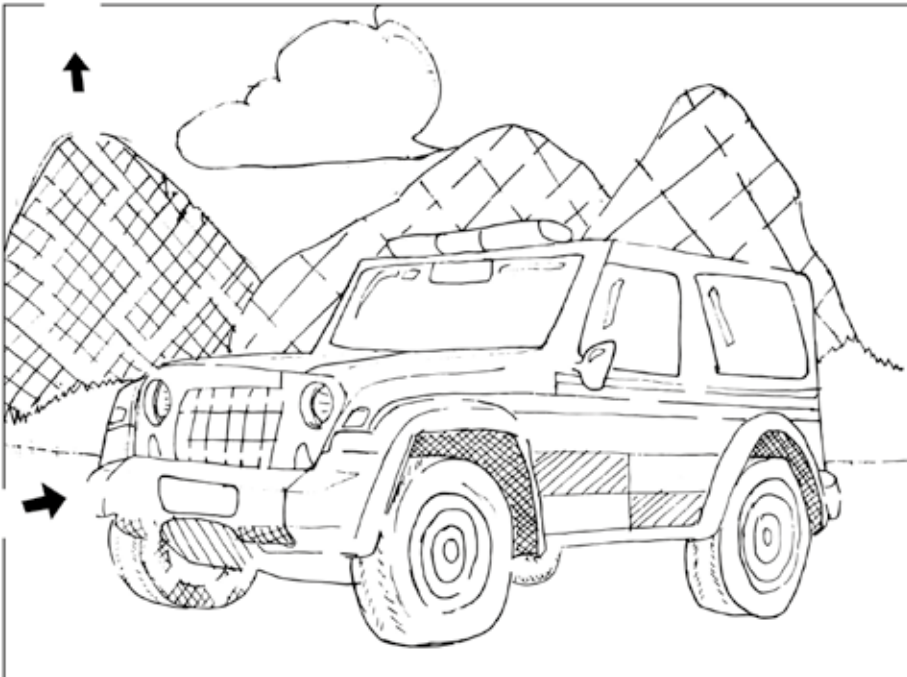

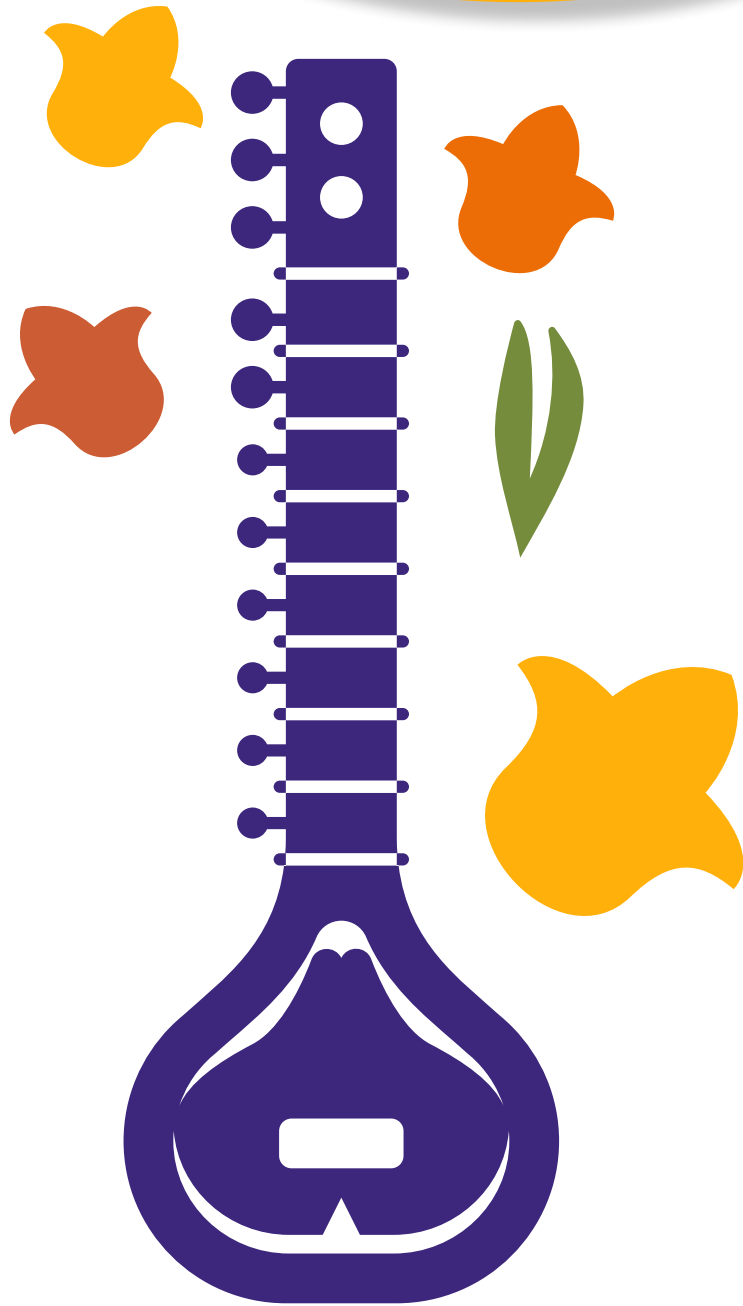
