

Craft Instructions



Travel journal

Children can use this journal to express what they are learning in each class and how to apply the lessons to their

Materials

- 7 White papers
- 1 Printed cover
- 1 Back cover
- Foamy pieces or colour paper (to decorate)
- Colours (to decorate)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Curly ribbon



Instructions

1. Place all the white papers together and place the printed papers as the cover and back cover.
2. Punch holes along one edge.
3. Thread curly ribbon through the holes and tie it to bind the journal together.
4. Decorate the cover by placing foamy pieces (or colour paper) and optionally colouring the rest of the picture.

Scanner

Children can use this craft by placing it outside their bedrooms and pretending to scan their hands before entering.

Materials

- 1 Base Pattern
- 1 Hand and button pattern
- 1 Plastic drinking straw per child
- Glitter (to decorate)
- Glue

Instructions

1. On the page with a hand and button to cut out, decorate the hand with glitter.
2. Cut pieces of straws and glue a few on the hand and on the numbers on the base pattern.
3. Cut or punch out the hand and numbers and paste them onto the straws on the base. This will give an effect like buttons when pressing the hand and typing the key.
4. Ask students to think of a code which only they will know. They should place the scanner outside their rooms and put the code every time they enter the room.



Mobile Phone

Materials

- Cell phone pattern (1 per child)
- Image slide
- Curly ribbon, 30 cm (1 per child)
- Bead (1 per child)
- Scissors
- Optional: Crayons or colours

Instructions:

1. Cut out the phone pattern.
2. Assemble the cell phone.
3. Thread the curly ribbon through the hole and tie on the bead.
4. Cut the image slide or strip of images so that it fits within the slots on the phone.
5. Play with the students to see what messages they are sending or receiving.
