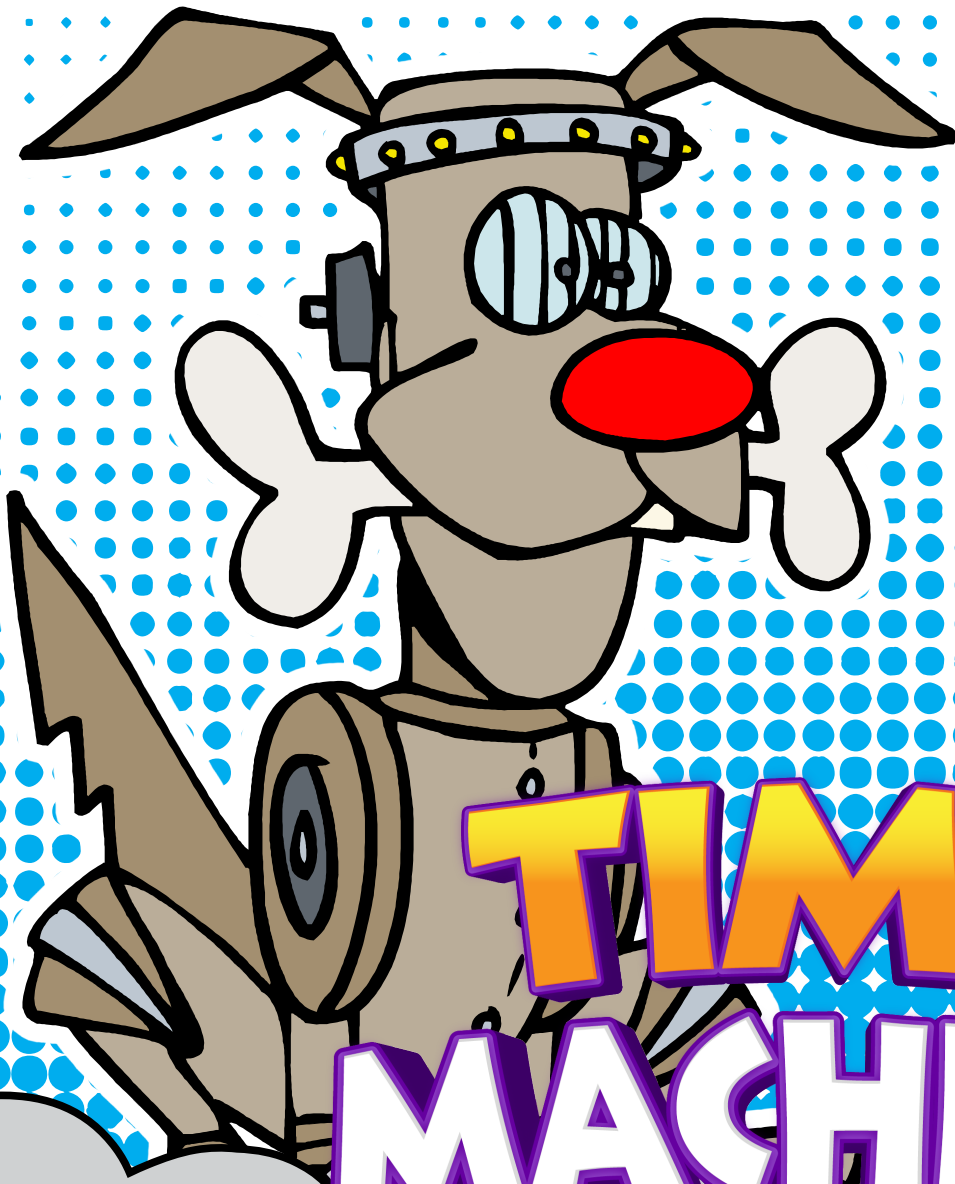

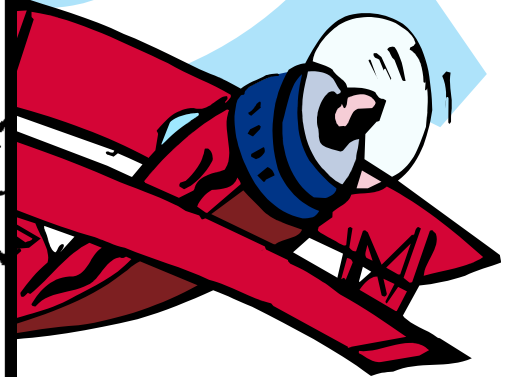

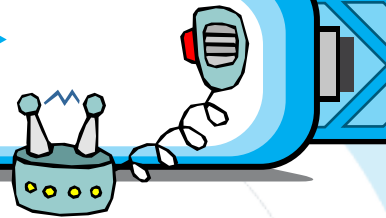
MEMORY VERSE

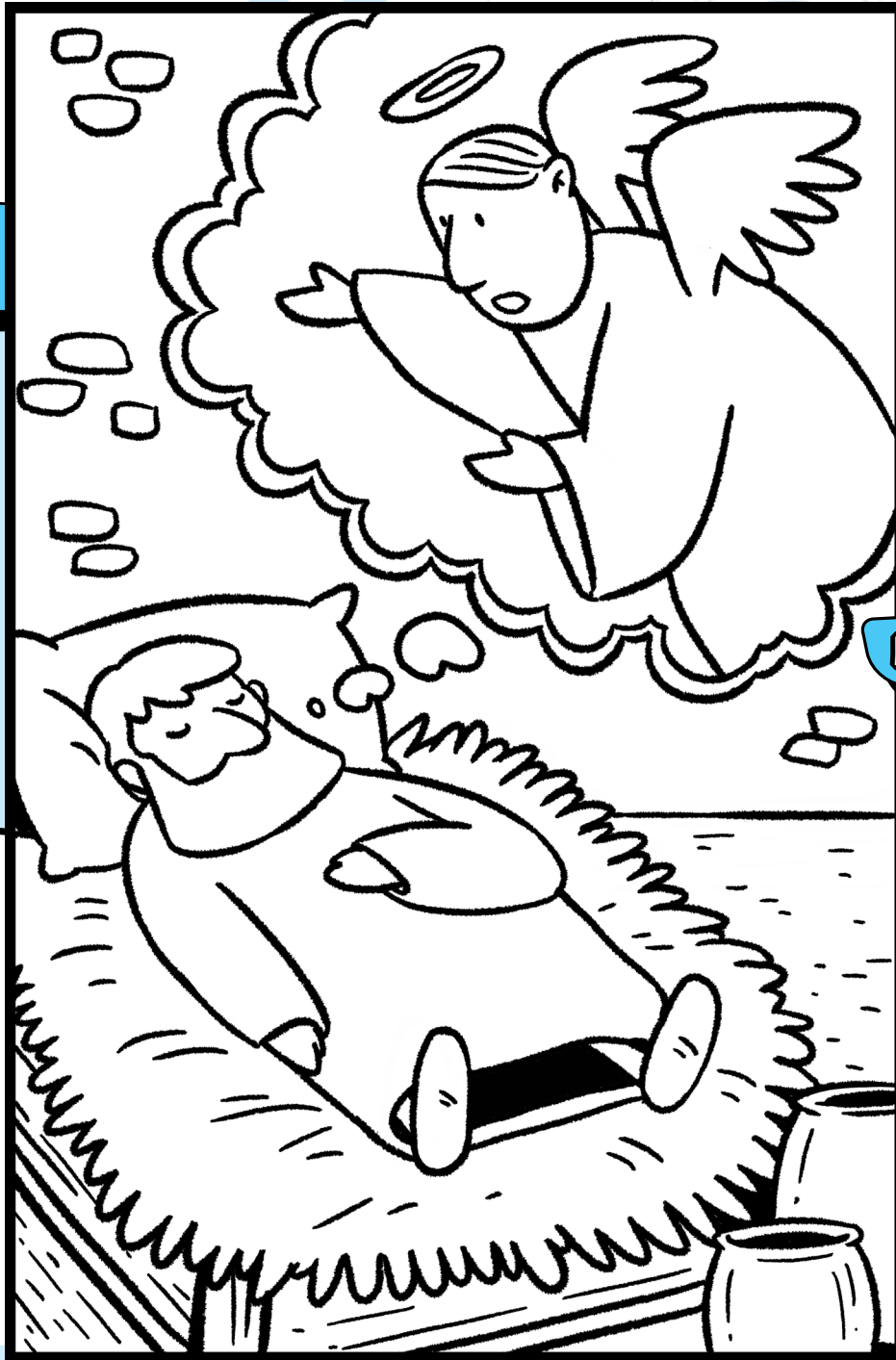


HOMEWORK

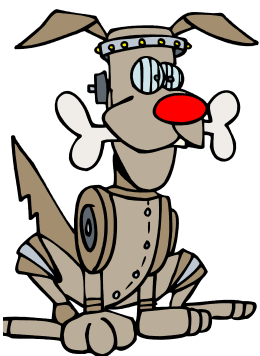


MEMORY VERSE

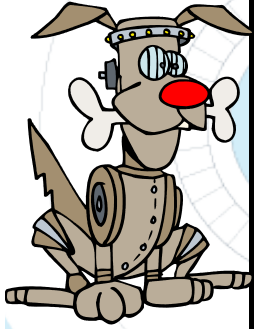
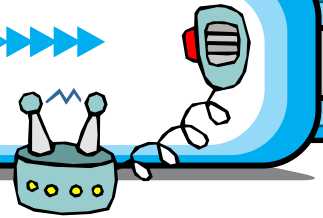
Find someone who moved recently and ask them questions until you discover something you have in common with them. What do you both enjoy? Invite them to your church.

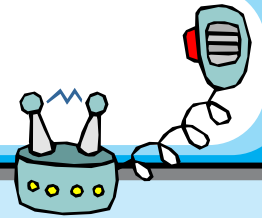


MEMORY VERSE

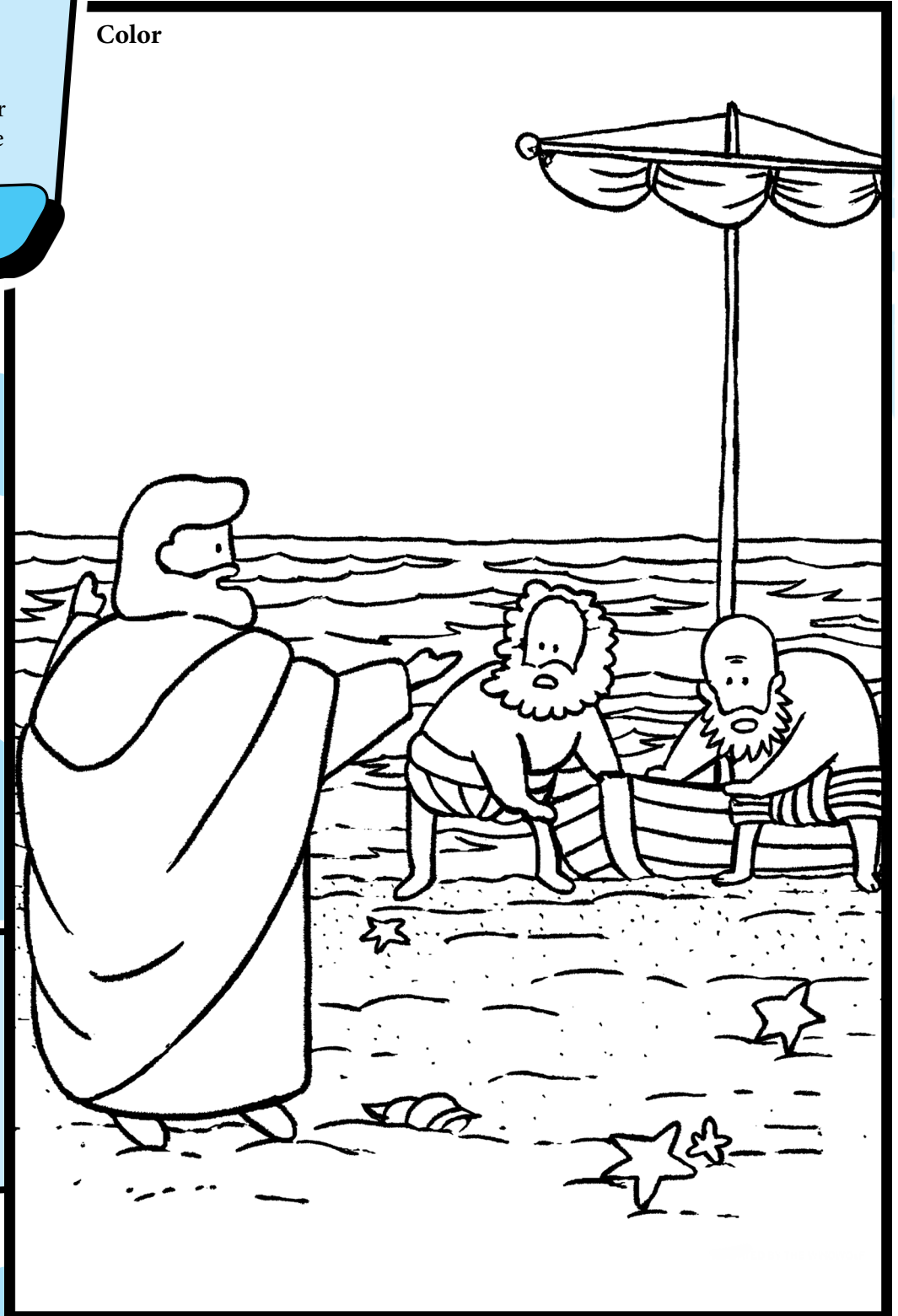

Invite someone to join your group of Christian friends who are learning more about who Jesus was and all He said and did. One way is to offer them a ride to church.

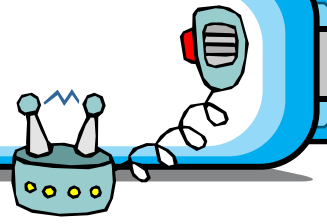

Ask God to show you what task you can do to help a neighbour and arrange with your neighbour when a good time is to come and do it.

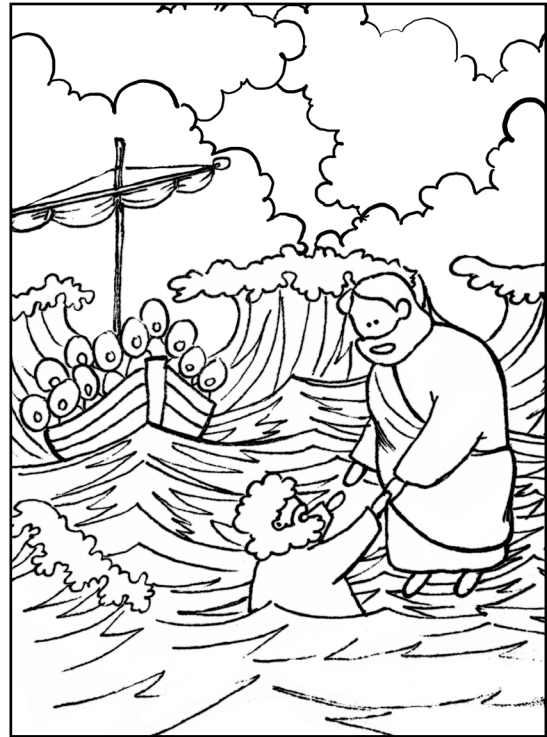
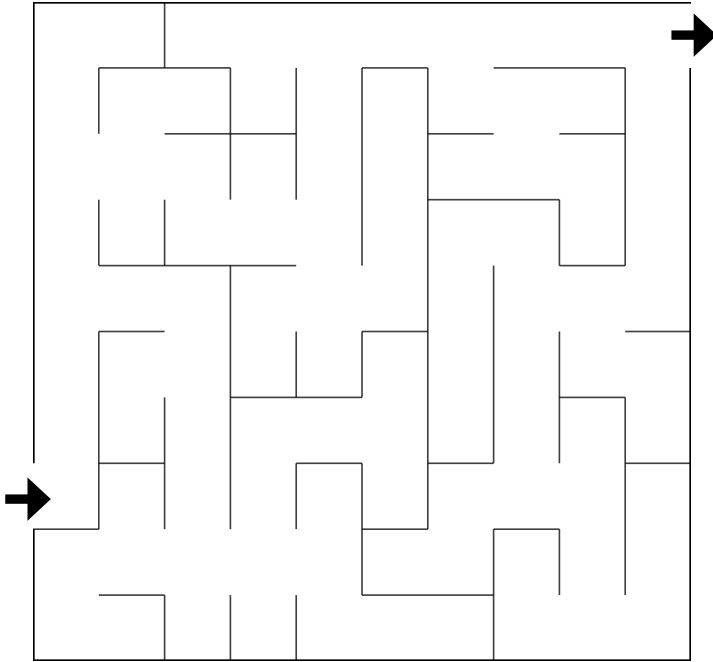
