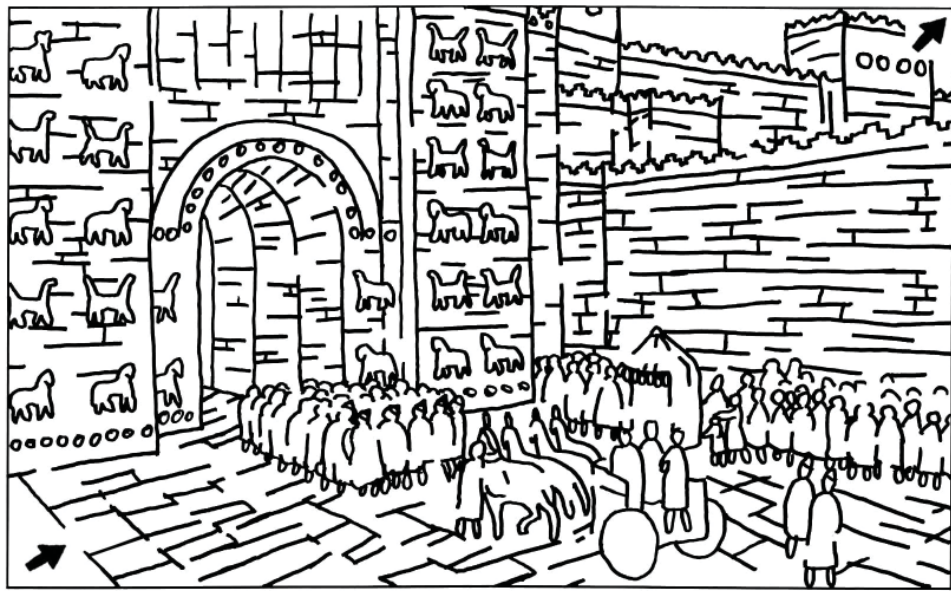

Daniel 1: A new home and school



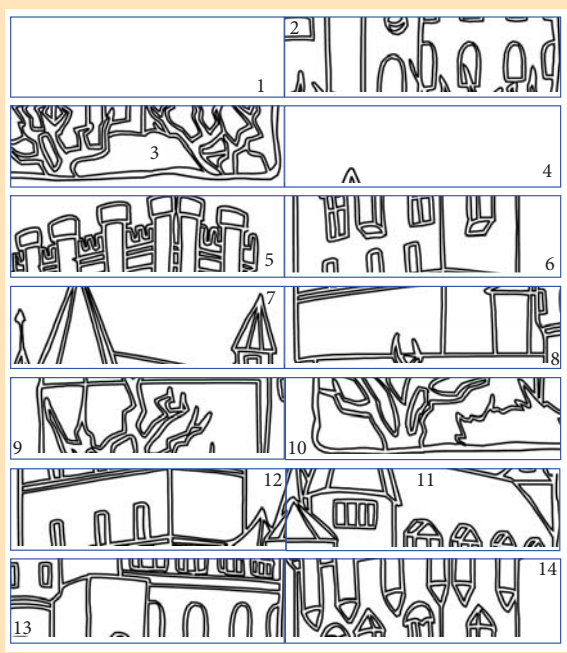
MEMORY VERSE

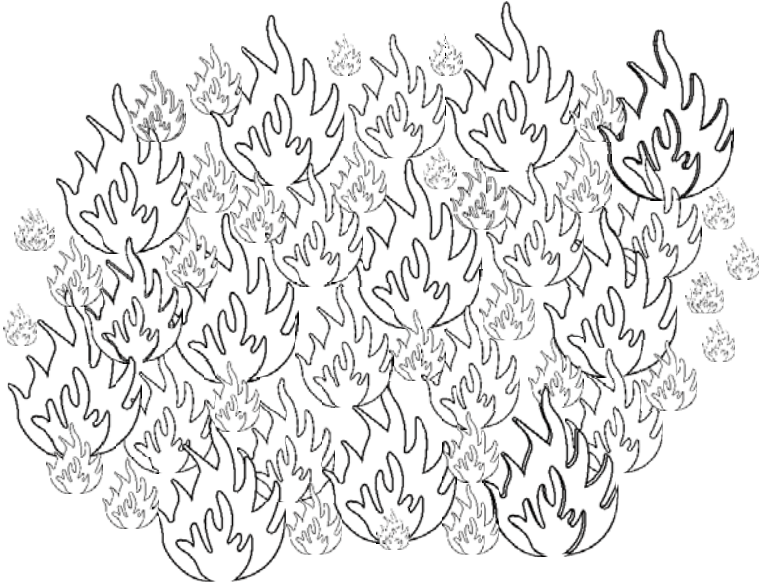

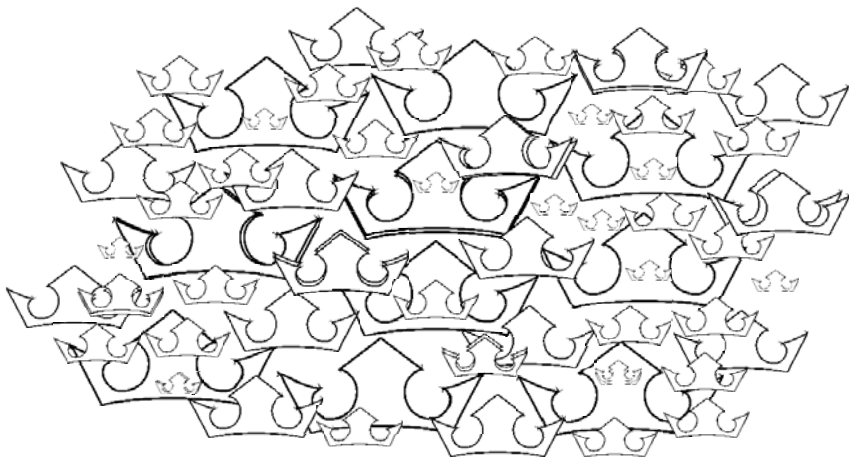

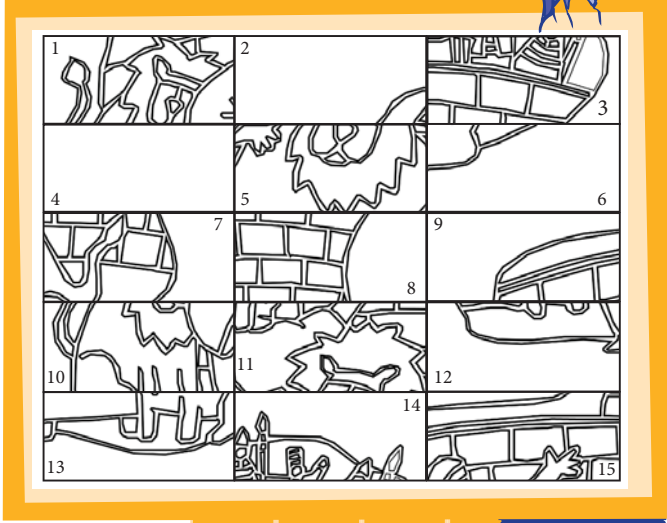
Hebrews 10:36 "You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised."

5. What happened after the King took Daniel out of the den?



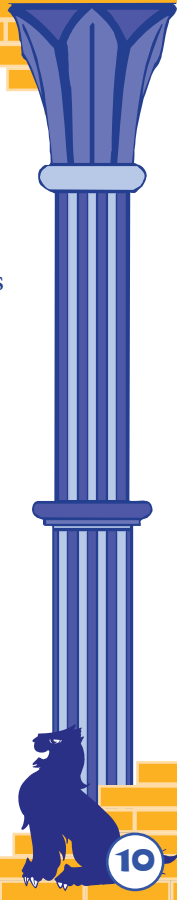
