

CRAFTS IN THE EMPIRE

1. HEART

MATERIALS

- Curly ribbon, 50 cm
- Paper heart
- Banner with Bible verse
- Glue
- Colours

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut out the heart and flag. Colour them with your favourite colours.
- 2. Glue both ends of the ribbon to the back of the heart to form a loop. Glue the flag piece in the centre of the ribbon.

2+ FURNACE

MATERIALS

- Paper furnace base pattern
- Paper flame shapes
- Colours
- Glue

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut out the furnace and flames. Colour the centre part of the furnace between the people (remember that the people were unharmed).
- 2. Colour the flame shapes with orange, yellow, and red to look like hot fire.
- 3. Fold the edges of the flame pieces and glue them onto the furnace so that they open like a door.

3. BABYLONIAN HAT

MATERIALS

- Paper hat pattern
- Colours
- Glue
- Curly ribbon, 50cm

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut out the hat pattern and colour it.
- 2. Fold along the dotted lines to make the hat overlap itself slightly as though it were 3 separate pieces.
- 3. Attach curly ribbon to the holes on either side to tie it onto the head.
- 4. Decorate with glitter.











4.PICTURE FRAME

MATERIALS

- Frame pattern out of foamy or colour paper
- 3 paper crowns
- Letters "I am brave"
- ¹/₂ drinking straw
- Curly ribbon
- Glue

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut out the frame pattern and remove excess pieces.
- 2. Fold it in half and glue 3 of the 4 edges. Leave the 4th edge open to insert a picture and leave the bands on top open to insert the straw.
- 3. Consider printing photos or having the children draw a picture of Esther to insert into the frame.
- 4. Decorate the crowns and the letters "I am brave."
- 5. To finish it, insert the straw into the bands on top and tie a curly ribbon on both sides of the straw to hang the picture frame.

5. LION MASK

MATERIALS

- Paper mask base
- Yellow foamy or colour paper with the face
- Orange foamy or colour paper for ears, eyebrows, and nose
- White foamy or paper for the mouth
- Curly ribbon, 50cm
- Colours
- Glue

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut out the base of the mask and colour it.
- 2. Glue the yellow foamy/paper on top as seen in the photo.
- 3. On top of that, glue the mouth and glue the nose on top. Also glue the ears and the eyebrows as seen in the photo.
- 4. Tie curly ribbon into the holes on both ends so that it fits the child's head.
